


Great Martyr Panteleimon

July 27




The holy, glorious and right-victorious Great Martyr Panteleimon the Unmercenary Healer was martyred under the reign of Emperor Maximian (ca. 305 A.D.).

Panteleimon was educated as a physician, and dedicated his life to treating the suffering, the sick, the poor and imprisoned without charge, thus, being known as a Holy Unmercenary. His popularity grew so much, that other physicians went to Emperor Maximian to complain. Panteleimon admitted to being a Christian and would not sacrifice to the gods. Throughout many tortures, the saint remained unharmed. He was finally beheaded. His body was then thrown into a fire, but came out untouched, and was buried by Christians. His holy head is located at the Panachrantos Monastery on the island of Andros.
